


Born in Worcester and now based in Stourbridge in the West Midlands,

The studio remains a family business and is run by Ineke's daughter Liske Johnson (BA Hons Textile Design), with the support of our close family friend Claire Lundy (BA Hons Printed Textiles).

SUZANNE NICHOLL

Growing up in Pembrokeshire, Suzanne was profoundly affected by the wild open spaces and unharnessed weather that graces the West coast of Wales.

She worked in healthcare for over thirty years before beginning to paint, and after attending Malvern School of Art in 2019, she found a new passion, and career as a professional artist.

Taking Inspiration from artists such as Joan Eardley, Barbara Rae, Joan Mitchell and Odilon Redon, Suzanne creates expressive, bold and colourful paintings that relay her experience.

Working outside, Suzanne creates numerous studies that capture the full sense of the landscape. Back in her studio she combines memory, sketches and found objects to create a series of work, in oils, cold wax and mixed media.

Suzanne uses contrasting and gestural marks, texture and colour to create dynamic movement and energy in her paintings, to recreate their inspiration and connect with our own experiences.

Suzanne currently lives in Worcestershire, but returns 'home' to the energy of the wind and sea as often as she can.



"I love to explore & work with a variety of mediums & textures to create fun, vibrant pieces that unleash a love of vibrancy, a joy for life, something to make you smile."


In painting Karen has discovered the ability to express the love she has for colour.


PAUL WHITEHOUSE

JEERROWLAND

Known for his rain-soaked oil paintings during a career that spanned over 30 years, Jeff combined a romantic 1950s feel with his signature rain motif. The anonymous kissing couple in his artworks represents a feeling of togetherness. For Jeff, rain symbolised washing away history and starting afresh, marking the start of a new journey. His figures are deliberately unidentifiable so viewers can relate to them.

To create his pieces, Jeff took photographs for reference before sketching the characters in a book. He painted the scene without rain and then added the couple in, before painting on the rain with a dry DIY emulsion brush.

Jeff said: "I'm never happier than when I've got a paintbrush in my hand. Over the years, I have started to choose more intense colours to create a focal point – a refuge if you will – from the rain."


